## **Grant Application Form**

The Essex Society for Archaeology and History ('ESAH') in furtherance of its charitable aims awards grants to support conservation, research and management of the archaeology and history of Essex. All grants are awarded at the discretion of the Executive Council. Please complete the interactive form if you wish to apply for a grant and submit to the Hon. Secretary. Grants will be awarded in January, April, July and October each year. If there are reasons why your application needs to be considered more urgently, please contact the Society's Hon. Secretary. Once the Council has reached a decision, applicants will be informed, normally by email, of the outcome of their application.

At present all payments are made by cheque, successful applicants are required to acknowledge the grant provided by ESAH in any publication or publicity about their project. In addition, successful applicants are required to provide a short note on their project for inclusion in the ESAH newsletter; for longer projects regular updates for the newsletter will be required together with and a note on conclusion of the work. For publication projects ESAH is keen to support work that is intended for one of its outlets, Essex Archaeology and History, Essex Journal or Occasional Papers but applications for work that is intended for publication elsewhere will also be considered.
